Kenneth L. Ludington, age 71 of Hamburg, IA passed away on December 23, 2018 at his home.

Kenneth was born on September 4, 1947 in Clarinda, IA; the son of Vernon and Mary Lois (Laughlin) Ludington. He graduated from South Page High School in 1966. He went on to obtain his Associate Degree from Iowa Western and his Bachelor's Degree in Business Management from Buena Vista College.
